### **ADDENDUM NUMBER 1**

The following modifications are made to the plans and specifications for the Brown County Landfill Cell #3 Construction & Drainage Improvements.

**1. Construction Contract and Specification Documents; Section 00 42 43 Bid Form; Addition of Alternate Bid 3 to the Bid Form:**

Alternate Bid 3 (add/deduct): Contractor Remove and Dispose of 100,000 cubic yards of soil material classified as weathered shale/shale. The contractor shall segregate at the existing stockpile location a quantity of approximately 100,000 yards of weathered shale/shale material. The Contractor shall be required to remove the 100,000 yards from the project site within one (1) year upon meeting substantial completion. The removal process shall be coordinated with the Owner and any necessary permits for hauling shall be obtained by the Contractor for this work. Attached is the revised Bid Form Page 36 and 37 of 436. Please dispose of existing pages.

**2. Construction Contract and Specification Documents; Section 00 42 43 Bid Form Part 2.01; revise to read**

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instruction to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid Security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for ~~60~~ **30** days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

**3. Construction Contract and Specification Documents; Section 01 57 00 Temporary Controls Part 3.03; add part B & C**

**3.03 DUST CONTROL**

- B. Water for dust control may be used from the existing sedimentation ponds around the landfill.
- C. The Contractor shall maintain a water truck and personnel available whenever work is being completed at the site for dust control purposes. The Contractor shall implement dust control measures whenever directed by the Owner or Engineer.

**4. Construction Contract and Specification Documents; Tech Specs Section 33 47 13.01 High Density Polyethylene Geomembrane; Clarification:**

This section pertains to the 60 mil Geosynthetic Liner indicated in the Bid Form and called for on the plans. The liner material shall be 60 mil HDPE textured on both sides and shall meet the requirement of this Section.

**5. Construction Plan Sheets; Sheet 9 - Future Grade Sedimentation Basin; Clarification:**

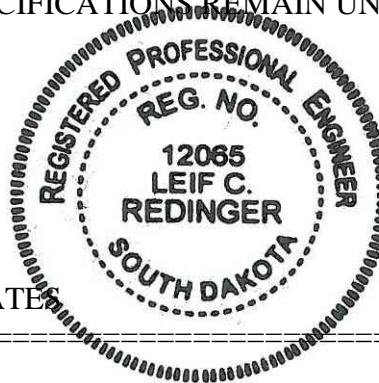
The underdrain piping from the nylo-plast inlet to the lift station shall be solid pipe. Quantity is included in the 8" HDPE Solid Leachate Piping Bid Item for this work.
