

INVITATION FOR BIDS

ONE ARTICULATED, 4-WHEEL DRIVE LOADER AND ATTACHMENTS FOR STURGIS MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

Sealed bids will be received by the City Council of the, City of Sturgis, 1040 Harley-Davidson Way, Sturgis, South Dakota, 57785, at the office of the City Finance Officer of said City until 2:00 pm (local time) on the 28th day of April, 2026, and then be publicly opened and read, for furnishing all equipment, labor, and materials as set forth in the specifications and performing all work, incidental thereto for Articulated, 4-Wheel Drive Loader with Attachments.

Copies of the Specifications are available for inspection at:

Office of the City of Sturgis, South Dakota, or at the Office of Helms and Associates, 416 Production Street, Aberdeen, South Dakota.

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with the specifications. All bids shall be plainly marked on the outside of the envelope with the words **“Articulated, 4-Wheel Drive Loader-Sturgis Municipal Airport”**

A Bid Surety is required for this bid. Each bid shall be accompanied by a ten percent (10%) Bid Bond or a certified check or cashier's check in an amount equal to at least five percent (5%) of the total gross bid, the same to be issued by a solvent bank authorized to operate in South Dakota. These securities are to be guarantees that if the Proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into by the Bidder.

Contracts awarded in excess of \$25,000 will require a Payment Bonds and a Performance Bonds, for one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract, in conformance with the requirements of the Contract documents. No bid may be withdrawn within a period of sixty (60) days after the date fixed for opening bids.

Award of Contract: The right is reserved, as the interest of the Sturgis, South Dakota, may require, to reject any and all bids, to waive informality in bids received, and to accept or reject any items of any bid, unless such bid is qualified by specific limitation.

The bidder will certify that he and any of his subcontractors meet the requirements of 49 CFR, Part 29, regarding debarment, suspension, ineligibility and voluntary exclusion as further described in these specifications.
