Sheet 59

The "Tracer Wire Detail" incorrectly shows a tracer wire access box at the water service location. Tracer wire shall be terminated at the nut on the curb stop lid as indicated in the specifications. Tracer wire access boxes are only necessary for the 20 sanitary sewer services and 6 fire hydrants.

Sheet 60

The "Typical 8" Drain With Grate Assembly" detail incorrectly shows SDR 26 PVC Pipe. The pipe shall may be SDR 35 PVC as indicated in the specifications.

SPECIFICATIONS

Section C-410 - Bid Form shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached bid form. The changes to the bid form are listed below:

The quantity for item 35 " 1" Water Service" was adjusted from 964 Ft to 934 Ft.
