# ADDENDUM NUMBER 1

The following modifications are to be made to the plans and specifications for the Wessington Springs School District Parking Lot Improvement Project.

#### **SPECIFICATIONS**

#### Section C-200 - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Paragraph 18.08. shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 18.08 The Bid will consist of one Bid Schedule and four Alternates which will be awarded as ONE Contract. The Contract, if awarded will be for one of the following combinations, whichever is in the best interest of the Project.
  - 1. Bid Schedule A, Alternate #2 and Alternate #4 (All Concrete Surfacing)
  - 2. Bid Schedule A, Alternate #2 and Alternate #3

    (East Lot Concrete Surfacing, West Lot Asphalt Surfacing)
  - 3. Bid Schedule A, Alternate #1 and Alternate #3 (East and West Lot Asphalt Surfacing)

#### Section C-410 - BID FORM

Section C-410 BID FORM shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached:

Bidders must provide prices for Bid Schedule A and ALL Alternates.

#### Section C-520 - AGREEMENT

Paragraph 4.02.A. shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 4.02 Contract Times: Dates
  - A. All Work will be substantially complete on or before <u>October 1, 2025</u>, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions within 30 days of the Date of Substantial Completion.

Paragraph 4.04.A. shall be added:

- 4.04 Milestones
  - A. The Work for the 8" Reinforced Concrete Paving in Bid Schedule A (Concrete Bus Loop) will be completed by <u>August 1, 2025</u>. All pavement markings may be completed at one time.

Paragraph 4.05.A.1 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 4.05 Liquidated Damages
  - 1. Substantial and Milestone Completion: Contractor shall pay Owner \$700 for each day that expires after the time (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract) specified above for Milestones and Substantial completion, until the Milestone is reached, or the Work is substantially complete.

### Section 31 24 13 - ROADWAY EMBANKMENT

The unclassified excavation quantity provided in Paragraph 1.05.A shall be revised to 1,700 CY.

#### Section 32 17 23 - PAVEMENT MARKING

Paragraph 1.04.D shall be added:

- 1.04 Measurement and Payment
  - D. Payment for pavement marking as shown in the Bid Form for the various alternates shall include the proper surface preparation for the pavement markings, as recommended by pavement marking manufactures, for that alternate.


#### 8.01 Bidder's Representations


- A. In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents the following:
  - 1. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, including Addenda.
  - 2. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
  - 3. Bidder is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
  - 4. Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
  - Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
  - 6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
  - 7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
  - 8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
  - 9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
  - 10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
  - 11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.





  - 3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.
  - 4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02.A:
    - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
    - b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.
    - c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.
    - d. Coercive practice means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.





# LONGITUDINAL SECTION OF CURB TAPER






1/2" Preformed expansion joint fillers shall be placed transversely in the curb and gutter at each junction of radius return curb and gutter and curb and gutter which is parallel to the project centerline and at intervals not greater than 150'.

Weakened plane joints shall be constructed at a minimum of 10' intervals. when the curb and gutter is to be constructed adjacent to PCC pavement, then the joints shall coincide with the pavement's joints. The joints shall be constructed to a minimum depth of two inches by scoring with a tool which will leave the corners rounded and insure a free movement of concrete at the joint.


# CURB AND GUTTER DETAIL


# CONCRETE PAVEMENT SECTION

# TIPPED OUT CURB AND GUTTER DETAIL


