

SECTION 00020 INVITATION TO BID

The City of Highmore, South Dakota, will receive sealed bids for their Highmore Community Building Drainage Improvements Project until March 23, 2026 at 2:00 PM. Bids can be hand delivered or mailed to the Finance Office at 125 2nd Street SW, Highmore, SD 57345 where the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time.

Bids are invited upon the general items of work as follows:

Bid Schedule A (Base Bid)

- 166 square yards of remove and dispose of asphalt surfacing
- 749 square yards of remove and dispose of concrete surfacing
- 100 cubic yards of remove salvage and replace gravel surfacing
- 1 each of remove, salvage and reset flagpole
- 179 linear feet of 6" PVC storm sewer pipe
- 298 linear feet of 12" PVC storm sewer pipe
- 4 storm sewer fittings
- 1 storm sewer manhole
- 1 connect to existing storm sewer inlet
- 5 connect to existing downspouts
- Replace one 4" PVC sanitary sewer service
- 2 connect to existing sanitary sewer main
- 720 cubic yards of unclassified excavation
- 590 tons of gravel surfacing or base course
- 160 tons of asphalt surfacing with fog seal
- 46 square yards of concrete surfacing
- 3,549 square feet of concrete sidewalk
- 2,321 square feet of concrete thickened edge sidewalk
- 254 linear feet of remove and replace concrete curb and gutter
- 142 square yards of concrete valley gutter
- 4 structural stoops
- 1,428 linear feet of 4" pavement marking
- 4 pavement marking symbols
- 4 handicap parking signs
- 26 square yards of seed and fertilize
- 24 square feet of traffic control signs
- 5 type III barricades

Alternate One A (Parking Lot Concrete Surfacing)

- 823 square yards of concrete surfacing
- 360 tons of gravel base course

Alternate One B (Parking Lot Asphalt Surfacing)

- 190 tons of asphalt surfacing with fog seal
- 500 tons of gravel base course

Alternate Two (Drainage Improvements)

- 64 linear feet of 6" PVC storm sewer pipe
- 334 linear feet of 12" PVC storm sewer pipe
- 4 storm sewer fittings
- 3 storm sewer manhole
- 5 connect to existing downspouts
- 100 tons of gravel surfacing

The approximate quantities mentioned above are subject to increase or decrease. It will be agreed by bidders that all quantities of work will be performed in accordance with the provisions of the specifications and at the unit price bid. Bidders agree to furnish all labor, material, and equipment necessary to complete all the work as shown in the plans and specifications.

The complete set of Contract Documents and specifications is on file with the Finance Officer, Highmore, South Dakota and/or at the office of Schmucker, Paul, Nohr and Associates, 2100 North Sanborn Blvd, Mitchell, South Dakota 57301. A paper copy of the contract documents and plans can be ordered with a non-refundable payment of \$35 plus applicable sales taxes. The contract documents and plans will also be made available at the SPN web site www.spn-assoc.com with a non-refundable payment of \$20. Upon request, one copy of the contract documents and plans will be furnished at no charge as required by SDCL 5-18B-1 to each contractor who is a South Dakota resident and who intends to bid the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the City of Highmore in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. A bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid will be accepted in lieu of a certified check or bank draft. Surety for bid bond must be authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota.

Pursuant to State Law, a copy of the bidder's sales and use tax license and a copy of the bidder's excise tax license as issued by the State of South Dakota must accompany the bid. In lieu of a copy of the license, the bidder shall submit appropriate evidence that the bidder and all affiliates have the appropriate licenses.

Bidders are advised that any contracts awarded on this project will be funded by the City of Highmore.

Bids may be held by the City Council of Highmore, South Dakota, for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids, investigating the qualifications of the bidders and completing financial arrangements prior to awarding the Work. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding and make awards in the Owner's best interest.
