

SECTION 00020 INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Ravinia, South Dakota, will receive sealed bids for their Storm Sewer Improvements Project until **September 6, at 5:30 PM** at the Fire Hall located at 202 Elm Avenue, Ravinia, South Dakota. Received sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above place and time.

Bids are invited upon the general items of work as follows:

Bid Schedule "A":

1. 700 CY of unclassified excavation
2. 3,000 SY of topsoil salvage and placement
3. 166 LF of 18" RCP storm sewer
4. 645 LF of 24" RCP storm sewer
5. 314 LF of 36" equivalent RCP arch storm sewer
6. 1,956 LF of 42" RCP storm sewer
7. 85 LF of bore and jack 42" RCP storm sewer
8. 9 EA storm sewer end sections
9. 5 EA 36" storm inlets
10. 11 EA 72" storm manholes
11. 1 EA 84" storm manhole
12. 90 LF of 4" PVC water main
13. 210 LF of 1.5" PVC water service
14. 70 TN of asphalt pavement
15. 200 TN of granular base course
16. 2,800 TN of Contractor furnished gravel surfacing
17. 37 SY of Class A Rip Rap
18. 6,300 SY of seeding and fertilizing
19. Miscellaneous erosion control
20. Miscellaneous traffic control

The approximate quantities mentioned above are subject to increase or decrease. It will be agreed by bidders that all quantities of work will be performed in accordance with the provisions of the specifications and at the unit price bid. Bidders agree to furnish all labor, material, and equipment necessary to complete all the work as shown in the plans and specifications.

The complete set of Contract Documents and specifications, is on file with the Finance Officer, Ravinia, South Dakota and/or at the office of Schmucker, Paul, Nohr and Associates, 2100 North Sanborn Blvd, Mitchell, South Dakota 57301. A paper copy of the contract documents and plans can be ordered with a non-refundable payment of \$35 plus applicable sales taxes. The contract documents and plans will also be made available at the SPN web site www.spn-assoc.com with a non-refundable payment of \$20. Upon request, one copy of the contract documents and plans will be furnished at no charge as required by SDCL 5-18B-1 to each contractor who is a South Dakota resident and who intends to bid the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the Town of Ravinia, South Dakota, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. A bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid will be accepted in lieu of a certified check or bank draft. Surety for bid bond must be authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota.

Pursuant to State Law, a copy of the bidder's sales and use tax license and a copy of the bidder's excise tax license as issued by the State of South Dakota must accompany the bid. In lieu of a copy of the license, the bidder shall submit appropriate evidence that the bidder and all affiliates have the appropriate licenses.

NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AFFIRMATIVE
ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT
OPPORTUNITY (EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246)

This project may be partially funded using American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. As a condition of the ARPA funding guidelines, the Contractor shall meet the following minimum requirements:

1. Based on the "Build America, Buy America" provisions of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and E.O. 14005 which provide that, as appropriate and to the extent consistent with law, a preference will be provided to Contractors for the purchase, acquisition, or use of goods, products, or materials produced in the United States (including but not limited to iron, aluminum, steel, cement, and other manufactured products). The Contractor shall provide documentation of their efforts to meet the provisions of "Build America, Buy America" upon request.
2. The Contractor shall make a good faith effort to utilize Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) and/or Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and shall provide documentation of the effort to solicit bids from qualified entities upon request.

The low responsive bidder must assure compliance with the requirements of Public Law 115-232, Section 889, Prohibition on Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment.

In addition to all of the above-listed Federal requirements for work on this project, compliance with the contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Executive Order 11375, Copeland Act, the Clean Air Act, and Water Pollution Control Act and subsequent amendments to all of the above will be required of contractors and/or subcontractors performing work on this project.

Bids may be held by the Town Board for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids, investigating the qualifications of the bidders and completing financial arrangements prior to awarding the Work. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding and make awards to the Owner's best interest.
